

## FAA Workshop - October 2017 Supply List Gelatin Printing Workshop

**Goody Bag** (Provided to each workshop participant). Each bag will contain:

- Junk Journal
- Package of white card stock
- Three (3) bottles of acrylic craft paint

**Other Materials Provided:**

- Freezer paper and tape
- Assorted stencils and masks
- Additional acrylic paint
- Mark and pattern making materials
- Newspaper, old phone books, catalogs, etc.
- Glue, skewers, fun foam
- Rubber stamps and ink pads

**Participant Supply List - REQUIRED**

- **Gelatin Plate** - Either 8 x 10 or 6 x 6 size. Search for *Gelli Arts Gel Printing Plate* online at Amazon.com, or Dick Blick, University Arts, etc.
- **Acrylic Paint** - Bring a supply of acrylic paints. All types of acrylic paint usually work: bottles, tubes, etc. You don't want to use oil paints or watercolors, and definitely not alcohol inks.
- **Scrap Paper** - Bring a supply of scrap paper to pull off extra paint from the gelatin plate and to test the process before using the "good" paper.
- **Brayer** - Used to spread the paint on the plate. This needs to be a rubber brayer, such as the ones made by Speedball, in either the 4" or the 2" size. These can be found on Amazon.com or art supply stores.
- **Scissors**
- **X-Acto knife and 8 x 10 or larger cutting mat**
- **Pencil and 12" ruler**
- **Black Sharpies** - Fine and Extra Fine points
- **Baby Wipes** - To clean the plate.
- **Paper Towels** - It's a messy process.
- **Spray Bottle with Water** - Also used to clean the plate.
- **Apron or Old Clothes** - Did we mention that it's a messy process?

**Participant Supply List - OPTIONAL**

- **Papers To Print On** - White cardstock will be provided, but you can bring a supply of other types of paper to print on. Examples: old maps, sheet music, tags, envelopes, blank gift cards, etc.
- **Stuff to Make Patterns With** - To make interesting patterns on the plate you can use many common household items, such as string, plastic fork, bubble wrap, plastic lids, lace doilies, potato masher, rubber stamps, etc. Don't bring anything that has sharp edges because you don't want to damage your gelatin plate.

- **Stencils and Masks** - Plastic stencils and masks to make designs.
- **Palette Knives** - Not required, but make sure they are the plastic ones, not metal.
- **Expired Plastic Cards** - Expired credit cards or gift cards are great for making marks or spreading paint
