## AGENDA PLANNED:

1. I'll show you what I mean by "The Color of the Air" (setting the mood) in your painting.
2. I'll show you some tricks on how you can mix your own colors using only six tubes of paint plus white, and almost never having to use black.
3. I'll discuss Color-Bouncing (reflected color); show it to you from life, and then show you how to use it in a painting with a short demonstration.
4. Everyone will choose a white cup or vase and some colored paper to use for the color-bouncing (I'll provide these). You'll practice what we learned and go home with a nice painting! It's a learning, practice painting!
5. We'll take a break for lunch, let all the new info sink in, and chat a while! It will be easiest if you bring a lunch.
6. For the duration of our workshop, you'll be the ones painting your still-life! I'll be there to help, to make suggestions, to answer questions. I WILL NOT "help you" by painting on your painting; (the way to learn is to DO), but I WILL show you on another surface so you can watch and then DO it yourself!
7. Last but not least, we'll admire our new paintings!
